Department of Commerce—Emergency Rule Relating To Carbon Monoxide Detectors



Under the nonstatutory provisions of 2007 Wisconsin Act 205, the Department of Commerce is directed to issue emergency rules pursuant to section 227.24(1)©, Stats., adopted as an emergency rule that took effect on October 1, 2008.

The Act mandates the installation and maintenance of carbon monoxide alarms in buildings accommodating certain types of residential occupancies and within which fuel burning appliances are located. Residential occupancies include tourist rooming houses, bed and breakfasts, and any public building that is used for sleeping or lodging, such as hotels, motels, condominiums, apartment buildings, dormitories, fraternities, sororities, convents, seminaries, community based residential facilities, home shelters, but NOT hospitals and nursing homes. The Act requires the installation of carbon monoxide alarms in new buildings as of October 1, 2008. The owners of EXISTING buildings will have until April 1, 2020 to install the carbon monoxide alarms. For further information and installation requirements refer to SECTION 3. COMM 21.095 SECTION 101.149 (2) and (3).
