NEW STATE OF WISCONSIN SAFETY LAW

Effective February 1, 2011:

- **All NEW AND EXISTING** residential dwellings that contain a fossil fuel burning heater **OR** appliance, fireplace, **OR** attached garage **MUST** install carbon monoxide alarms.
- Existing construction requires CO alarms must be either battery powered, plug-in, or plug-in with battery backup.
- New construction requires **ALL** CO alarms to be hardwired with battery backup.
- At least one CO alarm must be installed on every level of a dwelling, including the basement.

NOTE: A requirement for CO alarms in Wisconsin for rental units went into effect on April 1, 2010.

FYI:

- According to the AMA, carbon monoxide intake is the number one cause of accidental poisoning in the US. Still, an alarming 25% of American homes are not equipped with **any** CO alarms and another 23% have alarms that have never been changed/replaced.
- The NFPA recommends installing CO alarms outside **each** sleeping area **and** on every level of the home, including the basement.
- To ensure peak performance, replace batteries twice a year and check alarms monthly using the 'test' function. When properly maintained, a CO alarm has a life of approximately 5 years, after which it should be replaced with a new unit.
